

EIFTC COMMITTEES

Two subcommittees have been established to meet specific training needs, establish curricula, schedule classes and serve as a forum for business and industry and educators. Below is a brief summary of each committee.

Maintenance Committee

The maintenance committee meets quarterly to assess members' maintenance training needs, define curriculum and set class schedules. Class offerings include basic electricity, fluid power, welding, programmable controllers and HVAC, plus other classes as requested.

Classes are offered on-site or at Elizabethtown Community and Technical College.

Regulatory Committee

The regulatory committee meets quarterly to monitor and assess regulatory activities involving OSHA, labor law, wage and hour law, workers compensation and EPA in order to schedule training classes to meet the needs of member companies.

Classes are offered on-site or at Elizabethtown Community and Technical College.

AVAILABLE TRAINING FUNDS

There are several funding options available to member companies to help defer training costs.

BSSC

The Bluegrass State Skills Corporation grant covers 50 percent of training costs, provided three (3) member companies participate in a class.

KY WINS

The Kentucky Workforce Investment Network System grant covers 65 percent of training costs; however, blocks of classes must be planned in advance in order to qualify for this funding option.

OTHER

Funds are available through the Lincoln Trail Area Development District office.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

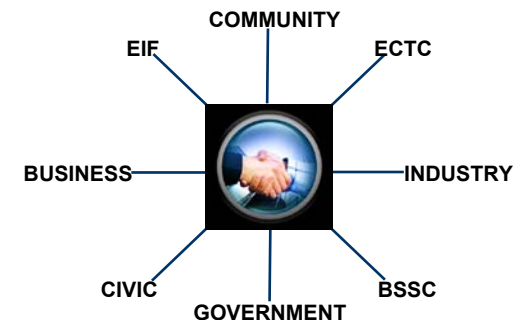
An Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation Training Consortium scholarship is available to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Applicant must be enrolled at ECTC on a full-time basis and meet the minimum academic standards.
- Applicant's parent/legal guardian or spouse must be employed by an EIF Training Consortium-member company (members listed in third column on inside of brochure).
- Obtain scholarship application from EIF member's Human Resources office.
- Submit the completed scholarship application to ECTC at the address and by the deadline listed on the application.

HISTORY

In the fall of 1987, several of Elizabethtown's existing businesses and industries began informal discussions of their need for upgrading the skills of their employees. With the help of the Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation and the Hardin County Plant Manager's Association, a training program was organized by local industry and Elizabethtown Community and Technical College to provide the training needed. A charter membership group was formed to satisfy this purpose and direction, and began operating under the title of the Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation Training Consortium (EIFTC).

Although initial course offerings were in the maintenance area, the selection has broadened to include computer applications, regulatory activities, and management training. Thus far, several thousand participants from over 50 businesses, industries, government agencies and the general public have attended EIFTC courses.

The unique success of EIFTC is the result of excellent cooperation among business and industry, Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation, Inc., and Elizabethtown Community and Technical College.
